### ENTRY FEES:

Masters, Veteran, Senior, Intermediate:	\$50 per grade
Junior, Sub Junior:	\$45 per grade
Juvenile, Primary:	\$35 per grade
Relays:	\$50 per team

### GRADES

<b>MASTERS:</b>	A skater who has reached the age of 45 years
<b>SILVER MASTERS:</b>	A skater who has reached the age of 55 years
<b>GOLD MASTERS:</b>	A skater who has reached the age of 65 years
<b>VETERAN:</b>	A skater who has reached the age of 35 years
<b>SENIOR:</b>	Open
<b>INTERMEDIATE:</b>	Under 19 years (16 - 17- 18 years)
<b>JUNIOR:</b>	Under 16 years (13 - 14 - 15 years)
<b>SUB JUNIOR:</b>	Under 13 years (10 - 11 - 12 years)
<b>JUVENILE:</b>	Under 10 years ( 7 - 8 - 9 years)
<b>PRIMARY:</b>	Under 7 years

**NB: Skaters must not have reached the age restriction before the original first day of the competition.**

All relay teams EXCEPT Men's and Women's teams may be mixed (ie male and female)

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 1) All skaters (other than those visiting from overseas) must be registered.
- 2) A skater may compete in two grades only.
- 3) The combining of grades is at the discretion of the officiating referee and competitors steward.
- 4) There will be no refund of entry fee for any skater who withdraws after the closure of entries without reasonable cause.
- 5) Names of relay team members must be handed in to the competitors steward prior to the commencement of the days racing. Late changes will be at the discretion of the chief referee.
- 6) The seeding times must be stated on the entry form and MUST be the most recent available. If no seeding times are provided, skaters will be drawn into heats after the seeded skaters.
- 7) Properly completed entry forms accompanied by the correct entry fee must be sent to the Organising Committee at the address below by the closing date. Only one entry per form will be accepted.
- 8) LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

**NB: Incomplete or incorrect entry forms will not be accepted.**

## **EQUIPMENT**

Club Team managers are requested to remind skaters that safety helmets, neck guards, gloves, knee and shin pads are compulsory equipment for all competitors in short track championships. Skaters must wear full bodysuits or similar which must be close fitting with no areas of skin exposed other than the face. Also blades must have tubes closed and blade ends rounded off with a minimum radius of 10mm.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP RULES**

All championship events will be conducted under the General and the Racing Regulations of Ice Speed Skating New Zealand. These will apply in conjunction with the Rules of the International Skating Union where applicable.

## **SHORT TRACK TROPHIES**

Club secretaries are requested to advise skaters holding Federation trophies, that these must be returned in the same condition as when they were presented.
